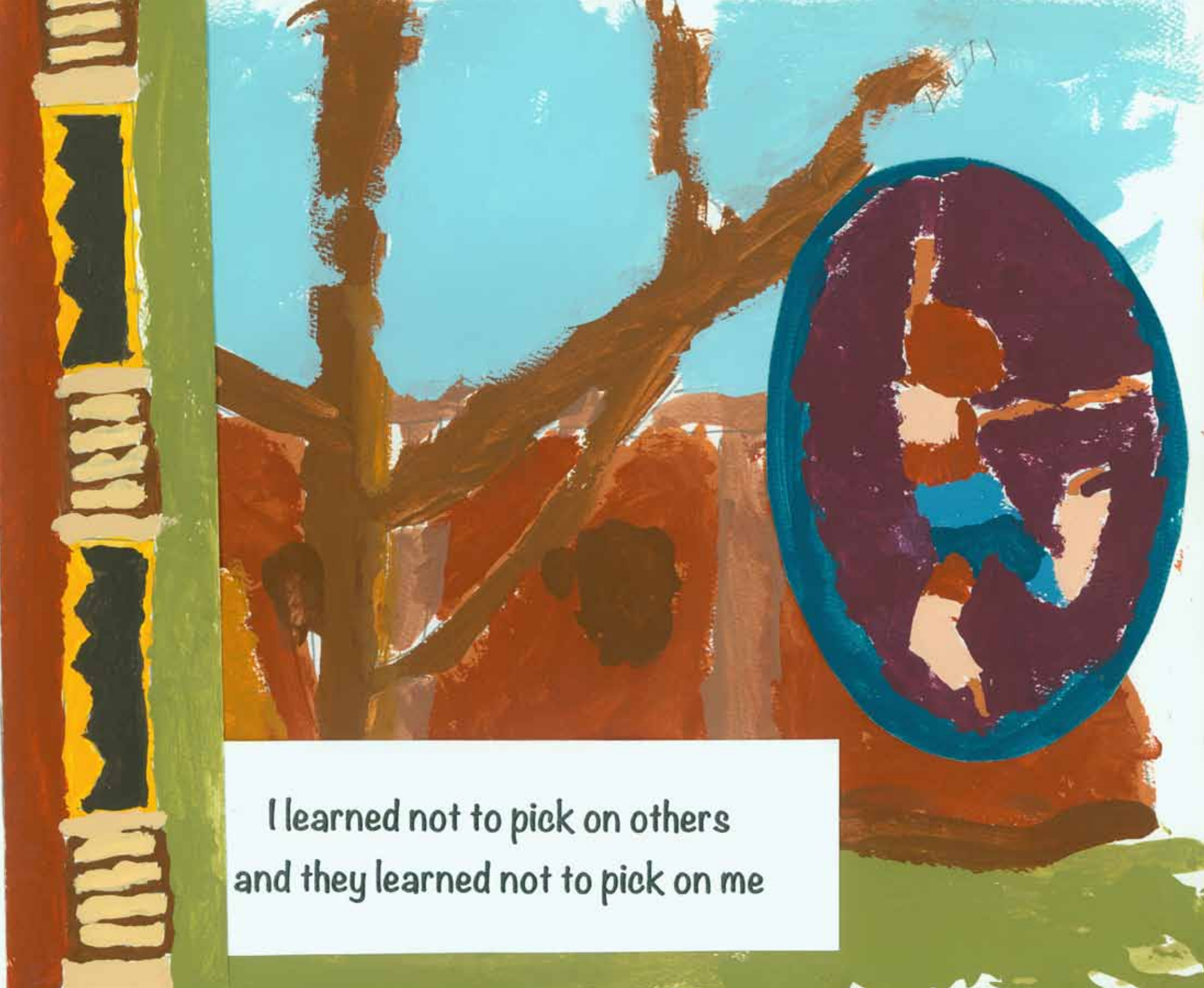

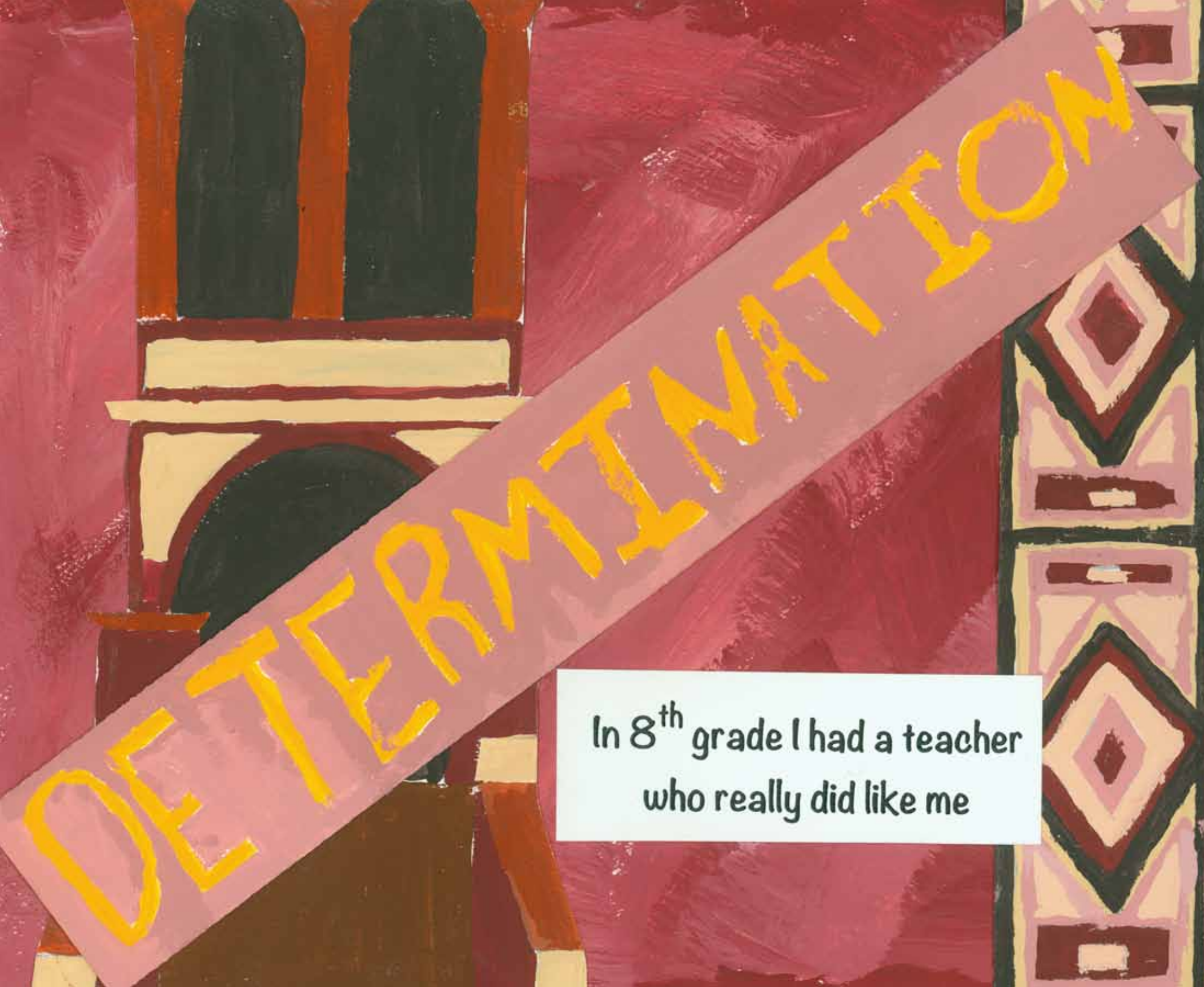
I never knew, if it were I

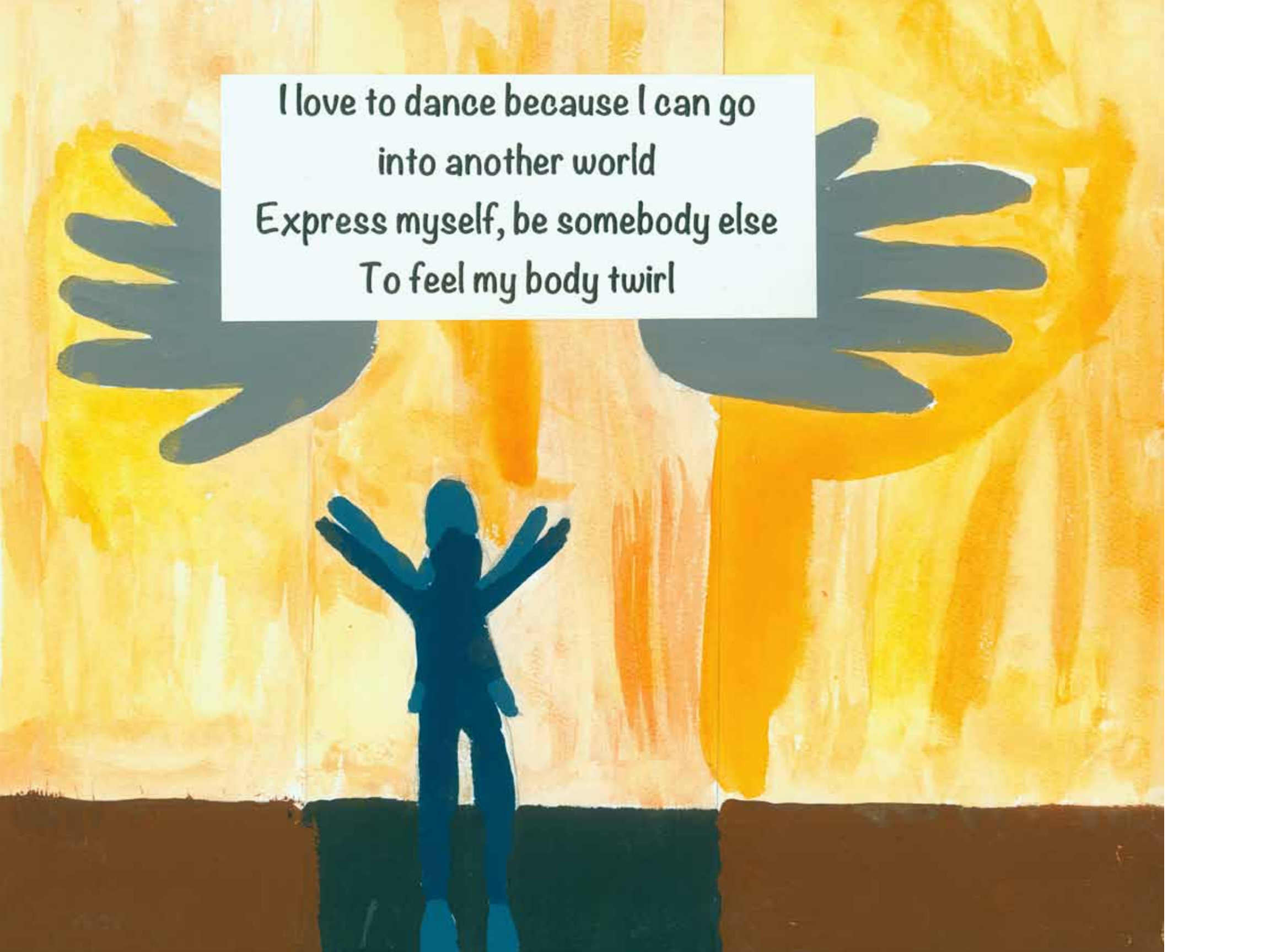
